Applications are reviewed by the Education and Scholarships committees of the HBA of Northwest Michigan. Scholarships will be awarded at the NWMI Skilled Foundation Annual Scholarship Awards Dinner on October 10, 2023. Past HBANWMI scholarship recipients and applicants are eligible to receive this scholarship. Multiple scholarships may be given.

# \$10,000 is Available for the 2025/2026 School Year

#### CRITERIA:

- Applicant's chosen field of study must relate to the residential building industry to include construction trades and supporting industries: landscaping, mortgage lending, architectural design, kitchen design, accounting, energy, environmental, interior design, real estate, and utilities. Or the automotive industry to include engineering technicians, service techs & mechanics, electronic equipment installers & repairers, body repairers, or other areas related to the automotive industry.
- 2. Must be a resident of one of the eight counties we serve: Antrim, Benzie, Grand Traverse, Kalkaska, Leelanau, Manistee, Missaukee, or Wexford county.
- 3. Must be a high school graduate or set to graduate in the spring of 2025 or sooner. Must provide copy of current transcript, grade report, or Certificate of Completion.
- 4. Must be registered for a college or a vocational school the 2025/2026 academic year.
- 5. Must demonstrate community involvement, leadership, and/or service.
- 6. Applicants are encouraged to submit a letter of reference/recommendation as a supplement to their application, preferably written by an active member of the Home Builders Association of Northwest Michigan.
